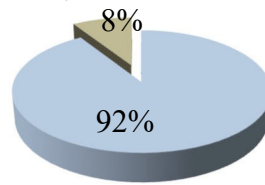

Transferability depends on college policies, grades earned, and how the course fits within your major. Colleges may limit the number of transfer credits accepted for incoming first year students. If credit is denied, you may be able to petition for re-evaluation.</p> <p style="margin-top: 20px;">Barnard, Bentley, Colgate, Fordham, Hamilton, MIT, RPI, Vassar, Union, U.
