## Basketball Camp | July 9-13

Boys and Girls, Ages 10 to 16

Coaches:

### **David Stevenson**

The 2010 Mid-State Athletic Conference Coach of the Year, Coach Stevenson has turned the TC3 men's basketball program into a power during his eight years on the bench. He is the most successful coach in the history of program, having set records for wins and winning the school's first conference basketball championship last year. Coach Stevenson's emphasis on developing student athletes both in the gym and in the classroom has led to his former players continuing their careers playing at top four-year institutions.

### **Jackie Sutton**

A graduate of TC3 and Dryden High, Coach Sutton took over the TC3 program for the 2010-11 season. An I.A.C. all-star in high school and a record holder at TC3, she earned an athletic and academic scholarship to Post University in Connecticut, playing both basketball and soccer while earning her bachelor's degree and her MBA. She was an all-conference and all-region soccer player at TC3 and was a team captain for both sports at Post, leading the Eagles to a pair of playoff appearances. As a coach, she works to develop both the team and each individual student athlete.

## Boy's Lacrosse Camp | July 23-27

Ages 8 to 15 | **must provide own equipment**

Coaches:

### **Jimmy Fey**

2012 is the fourth year Coach Fey has been connected to the TC3 program, having started as an assistant in 2009 before taking over as head coach last year. A former Academic All-American at Broome Community College, he continued his playing career at Cazenovia College. While at Cazenovia, he was captain, team MVP, and president of the Cazenovia Student Athlete Leadership team. He graduated as a dean's list student from Cazenovia and coached at Vestal High School before coming to TC3.

### **Chuck Little**

Currently in his fourth year as an assistant at TC3, Coach Little has significant experience both as a coach and a player. He played professionally after graduating from Ithaca College and served as a head coach on the high school and college levels prior to coming to TC3. His lacrosse experience includes working for several regional and national summer camps.

## Softball Camp | June 27, 28, 29

(three-day camp)

Girls, Ages 10 to 18

Coaches:

### **Brent Doane**

In 10 seasons at TC3, Coach Doane's teams have averaged more than 24 wins per season, won three straight regional titles, and finished in the top four in the nation each of the last three years, including winning the title in 2009. Coach Doane, who coached softball at Cornell University before taking over at TC3, has led the Panthers to the playoffs eight times and averaged over 25 wins per season. He was the NJCAA National Coach of the Year in 2009 and also serves as president of the NJCAA Softball Coaches Association and as the Division III representative.

## Soccer Camp | July 16-20

Boys and Girls, Ages 6 to 13

Coaches:

### **Andy Davis**

A three-time conference coach of the year, Coach Davis has led the Panthers to three conference titles and five regional final four appearances in his seven seasons as head coach. He brings tremendous credentials to the program, both as a player and a coach. An all-state player in high school he was an All-American and national player of the year in college. Prior to coming to TC3, he served as an assistant coach at SUNY Cortland for two seasons, helping the Red Dragons to two SUNYAC titles. He spent one season as an assistant at TC3 before taking over the program and has amassed a record of 85-48-5 during his seven years as head coach.

### **Robert Rice**

Coach Rice takes over as head coach of the TC3 women's soccer program in 2012, but he's not new to the College. He has coached soccer at TC3 for six seasons, working as an assistant with the men's program for four years before joining the women's program for the last two. His teams made the NJCAA playoffs each season, and during that span he has coached 32 all-conference players, 20 all-region players, and 4 All-Americans. He has also coached basketball and softball at TC3.
