This hands-on workshop is geared towards the types of applications that are most relevant to those in the Communications & Media Arts field, including animation and integration with Premiere Pro and After Effects. Chrissy will provide an overview of how to use Photoshop for video/media arts applications, including rotoscoping, web animation, stop frame, and building multimedia for various platforms. This will not cover all Photoshop tools, but will focus on those most useful to video/new media teachers and students.
