Note: HSTY 225 & 233 satisfy the SUNY GEN ED American History area only if a student has received an 85 or higher score on the NYS Regents US History & Government Exam.

+ A student exempted from ENGL 100 must substitute a three credit unrestricted elective. The course should be selected in consultation with the student's advisor.

* If a student selects a history sequence that includes HSTY 110 **or** HSTY 111 **or** HSTY 252, he/she may "double-dip" since these courses also satisfy the Global Requirement. As a result, the student would need to complete at least 15 credits of unrestricted electives.

** Courses should be selected in consultation with the student's advisor and should be based on requirements at the intended four-year transfer institution. Up to 3 FITN credits may be used toward Unrestricted Electives requirements.
