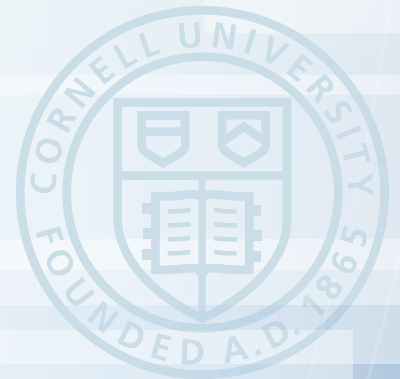


# Workshop on Connecting Community College Education with Research in Physics and Engineering
