



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT between
Tompkins Cortland Community College and
Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga BOCES
(Criminal Justice Programs)

This articulation agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing the Criminal Justice Year 1 and Year 2 Certificate at the Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga BOCES Career & Tech Center and will continue their education at Tompkins Cortland Community College. This agreement certifies that previous learning experiences at BOCES can be transferable to Tompkins Cortland Community College, when additional agreed upon conditions have been met by the student.

Secondary Courses Certified:

Criminal Justice Year 1 and Year 2 courses offered during students' junior and senior years at Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga BOCES.

Comparable Tompkins Cortland Community College Courses:

Three (3) credits for CRJU110, Police Patrol Operations, will be granted, if the conditions listed below are met.

Conditions For Awarding Articulated Credit:

Tompkins Cortland Community College has agreed to grant college credit for students completing the Criminal Justice Year 1 and Year 2 courses at Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga BOCES. The particular credits that have been articulated are listed above.

The following criteria must be met in order for a student to apply for articulated credit:

1. The student must have completed both the Criminal Justice Year 1 and 2 courses with a grade of "B" or better, or 80% or better.
2. The student must have completed Tompkins Cortland Community College course CRJU 105: Introduction to Criminal Justice with a grade of "C" or better.
3. The student must complete their first full-time (12 credits or more) semester of courses at Tompkins Cortland with a grade of "C" or better for each course.
4. Lastly, the student must meet with the Program Chair of Criminal Justice, who, after verifying that the above requirements have been met, will forward the documentation to the College Registrar who will grant credit for CRJU110, Police Patrol Operations, which will be entered on the student's transcript.
