

All international applicants must document their ability to meet all educational and living expenses for the entire period of their intended study before this College can issue a Certificate of Visa Eligibility (form I-20). Read the following instructions carefully before completing and submitting this form.

Instructions

Part I	Answer all questions completely.
Part II	Indicate the source(s) of your funding. Indicate the amount (in U.S. dollars) available for each year of study. Each sponsor must verify these amounts by submitting verification of amounts with certification of accounts with official signature/seal. Be sure to include supplementary documents as indicated, and attach originals, not photocopies. All documentation must be dated within one year of the date of initial enrollment. You have an estimate of our annual education and living costs for international students. You must document financial support equal to or greater than this amount. This estimate is subject to change without notice and will usually increase each year.
Personal/Family	Bank verification and separate statement of account
Scholarship	Official scholarship letter from institution awarding the scholarship. The award letter must contain the name of the applicant, the amount of money available for each year of study, the duration of the award (including beginning and ending dates), the degree and major field of study for which the award is tenable, and the name of the campus to which the award is applicable.
Government or Employer	Official letter indicating amount of support and containing the same information as for "scholarship" described above
Loans	Official letter from credit institution indicating approval of loan and the amount of loan approved
Dependent Support	A student wishing to have his/her family member(s) accompany him/her must document the following amounts for each family member per calendar year of intended study: For Spouse: \$3000 per calendar year For Child: \$1800 per calendar year

Tompkins Cortland Community College reserves the right to require additional financial documentation and/or pre-payment from applicants whose countries impose currency exchange restrictions or other obstacles to the transfer of currency. Applicants from such countries will be notified of specific requirements when they have submitted complete applications.
