

Beautiful Women and Genuine Men: Journeys in Stories Stills at TC3

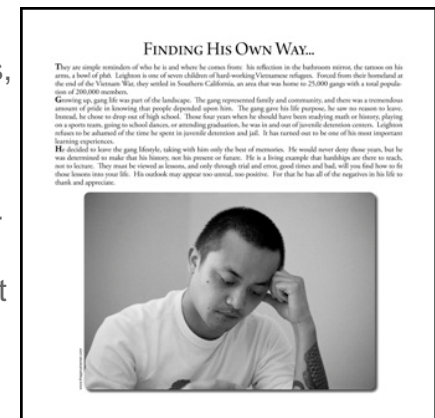
